



## Holocaust Survivors Service Internship JUS 205/REL 406

- ➤ Unique, once-in-a-lifetime opportunity to meet with survivors of the Holocaust who currently reside in South Florida.
- > Students are expected to *commit to two semesters* of service for 3 credits each semester involving at least 4 meetings with a survivor.
- > Students interns will also meet several times each semester with a UM faculty member to share their experiences and to participate in enrichment activities.
- > Students will earn a stipend of \$250 per semester (based on number of visits) to cover any transportation costs.
- > Outstanding interns will also be eligible for a Sue Miller Scholarship.
